Biography/History:

Sylvia Kathleen Flanigan (1946-2003) was born in Evansville, Indiana and moved to San Diego at the age of 12. An educator, Ms. Flanigan specialized in alternative continuing education in the San Diego Unified School District, primarily at the high school level. She graduated with honors from San Diego State University in 1976 and went on to earn a master's degree from the University of San Diego in 1985 with an emphasis in architectural history. Ms. Flanigan served two terms on the board of directors of Save Our Heritage Organization and also served at various times on the La Mesa Historic Preservation Commission, the Gaslamp Quarter Foundation board of directors and the Whaley House board of directors.

For more than 20 years, Ms. Flanigan was involved in historical surveys and studies, along with historical designations, throughout the region. Ms. Flanigan was very active in the San Diego Historical Society's Research Library. She published numerous articles in the *San Diego Journal of History* including "The Baja California Gold Rush of 1889," "The Ranch House at Warner's," "William Sterling Hebbard: Consummate San Diego Architect," and "Frank P. Allen, Jr.: His Architectural and Horticultural Imprint on San Diego." Other research projects included a 250-page report on Highway 101 that led to the formation of the Highway 101 Association and was instrumental in the state's historic designation of the route. Another of her projects, "San Diego's Historic Gaslamp Quarter: Then and Now" (1989), which Ms. Flanigan co-authored with Susan Carrico Bugbee, was re-issued by Tecolote Publications in 2003.

In 1994, she received the Architect Marc Tarasuck Award in the San Diego Historical Society Institute of History. She received the Preservationist of the Year award from Save Our Heritage Organization in 2003. The same year Citizens Coordinate for Century 3 honored her for her monumental research that led to the placement of the County Administration Center on the National Register of Historic Places.

Scope and Content:

The Flanigan Collection is Ms. Flanigan's working file compiled during her years of research in the San Diego area. As an architectural historian, she assembled research files on all the major San Diegan architects and their styles; attained copies of key research sources pertaining to construction companies and architects (such as the Los Angeles Contractor and Builder); and meticulously saved her research and final reports for historic home and historic district designations. Her work on historic designations led her to a variety of topics of San Diego history which is reflected in her subject files...
